


JOINT STATEMENT
OF THE 10TH INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM FOR TRANSPORT UNIVERSITIES
OF ASIAN-PACIFIC COUNTRIES

Seoul Declaration For cooperation Transport and Logistics
Seoul, Korea, 1 November 2017

1. The 10th International Symposium for Transport Universities of Asia-Pacific Countries, hosted by International Association of Transport Universities of Asian Pacific Countries and organized by Korea National University of Transportation was held in Nov 1st. 2017. Under the theme “the Eurasia Transportation & Logistics System for the 4th Industrial Revolution”, researchers and delegations from China, Indonesia, Japan, Kazakhstan, Mongolia, Korea, Russia, Uzbekistan and Vietnam shared their development situation as well as its vision in its neighboring countries in the Eurasian region. We also predicted the change of transport and logistics systems triggered by Mobility 4.0 technology development and discussed measures to enhance cooperation among its regional countries to react to the change:
 - Confirm the potential development of the regional countries in Eurasia and its economic complementation;
 - To secure the drive engine for co-prosperity and growth in Eurasia, we appreciate that it is necessary to establish efficient transport and logistics networks and boost its connectivity; and
 - With the advent of the 4th industrial revolution that requires a completely new paradigm shift in Eurasia, we relate to the necessity for the co-response to the change and make endeavors to share the results of research.
2. We have laid a foundation for communication and collaboration by hosting the General Meetings and the International Symposiums for 9 times. To mark the 10th anniversary of the Association, we confirm the importance of mutual partnership among Eurasian countries and share the view to build the platform, “Eurasia Transport Research Center” that is capable of promoting practical and sustainable education as well as research.

As of this year, the Association, which consisted of Transport Universities in Russia, Mongolian, Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan, extended its range to the Southeast Asian Universities including Vietnam and Indonesia. With the participation of Transport Universities in Eastern Europe in near future, we have agreed to develop into the number one Transport University Association in Europe and Asia.
4. The 10th International Symposium for Transport Universities of Asia-Pacific Countries was hosted in Seoul, Korea and its conclusion were released from Nov.1st to Nov.3rd. This statement was announced in The 10th International Symposium for Transport Universities of Asia-Pacific in Nov.1st, 2017.
